

LAISSEZ PASSER

A laissez-passer is a travel document that the Brazil Embassy will issue to individuals holding a passport issued by a Government not recognized by the Brazilian Government.(art. 56 da Lei nº 6.815/80 e art.14 do Decreto nº 5.978/06).

Visas will be issued on a laissez-passer to individuals from:
Buthan, The Comoros Islands, Central African Republic and Taiwan

In order to obtain a laissez-passer travel document, fill out the [online visa request form](https://scedv.serpro.gov.br) - <https://scedv.serpro.gov.br>

- 1) After you reach the SCEDV website, click on VISA;
- 2) Once you have reached the third tab titled “DOCUMENTS,” choose the “LAISSEZ-PASSER” option on the drop-down menu for “TYPE”;
- 3) Follow all the instructions, fill it out, print the receipt, SIGN IT and attach a 3X4 cm recent photo;
- 4) Include proof of legal residency in Australia with completed visa application;
- 5) Include Consular Fee of AUS\$ 112.00 per laissez-passer, IN ADDITION to the fee of the visa you are applying for :
 - a. Tourist Visa AUS 28.00 (in person) or AU\$ 56.00 (by mail or by a third party);
 - b. Business Visa AUS 84.00 (in person) or AU\$ 112.00 (by mail or by a third party);

The Embassy of Brazil in Canberra ONLY accepts payments in the form of a Money Order issued by the Australian Postal Service, payable to “Brazil Embassy”. Personal cheques, credit cards, or any other forms of payment are not accepted.

The processing time for a laissez-passer is of minimum 10 working days.
