

PERMANENT VISA – PERSONAL **INVESTMENT IN BRAZIL**

Authorisation by the Ministry of Labour in Brazil is required prior to visa application.

Eligibility

1. This visa may be granted to individuals intending to establish permanent residency in Brazil as investors.
2. Being able to invest a minimum of R\$ 500,000.00 (five hundred thousand Brazilian Reais), presenting an investment plan.
3. This kind of visa may also be granted to the dependants of the applicant (please check conditions applicable with the authorities listed below).

Processing time and checking the status of your visa application

PROCESSING TIME- After all application requirements are met, the processing time is approximately:

- Fifteen (15) working days.
 - The Embassy of Brazil does not provide express or priority services.
1. These estimated processing times do not include:
 - The time an application is held by a travel or visa agency;

- The time the applicant takes to provide additional information/documents subsequently required by the Consulate;
- The time in the mail.

2. Please write down the tracking numbers of the envelopes sent with your application (we advise using express post/express post platinum).

3. The embassy of Brazil in Canberra does not take responsibility for lost or delayed correspondence.

PLEASE NOTE: The processing time may increase for group visas and other special cases, and in times considered high season.

VISA STATUS- Applicants can check the status of their visa application [here](#) (Click "CHECK STATUS"). When your application status is listed as "Ready for Delivery," your visa application has been processed.

Minimum Documentation Requirements for the visa application (after authorization is issued by the Brazilian Ministry of Labor)

A. Original Passport valid for a minimum of 6 (six) months. The passport must have at least one blank page.

B. One recent professional passport size photograph (3x4 cm) frontal, with white background (please follow specifications given in the internet form - see link below). No other photos are accepted.

C. Visa Request Form: fill it out, print the receipt, sign it and attach the photograph mentioned on item B (above) in the appropriate box. Photos over 6 months old will not be accepted.

With a view to improving processing time, all visa applications **MUST** contain electronic copies of photo, signature and other relevant documents. Please note that hard copies of the photo and documents must still be presented alongside the visa request for analysis.

As of 24 August 2015, the Embassy **WILL NOT** process visa applications **UNLESS** these documents are uploaded when completing the online application form.

Insert your name and contact number (NOME DO CONTATO/TELEFONE) to enable us to reach you if necessary.

D. AFP National Police Check, (fingerprint and name check).

E. Notarized letter of consent signed by father and mother or guardian (proof of guardianship required), for applicants younger than 18 years old when traveling alone. If traveling with one parent only, notarized letter of consent of the non-accompanying parent is required. Please fill the form "travel authorization for minors" that you will find at the end of this section, under "Other Forms".

HOW TO PAY:

BY POST: Australian Post Money Order or Bank Cheque (personal/company cheques are not accepted), made out to EMBASSY OF BRAZIL.

NO Auspost (online service) delivered money order will be accept.

IN PERSON: Money order as above or EFTPOS (debit or credit - VISA/MASTERCARD).

How To Apply:

A) Visa by mail

Applicants should send all required documentation and payment of fee as stated above plus a self-addressed, pre-paid, registered envelope of suitable size to the Embassy of Brazil in Canberra (see address below). Updated information on post charges is available at Australia Post offices. **DO NOT SEND CASH**, either for fees or for postage. The Embassy of Brazil does not provide express or priority services.

B) Visa in Person

Applicants should bring to the Embassy of Brazil in Canberra (see address below) all required documentation and the payment of fee as stated above. Once ready, you may pick it up in person or you may include a self-addressed, pre-paid, registered envelope of suitable size. **DO NOT BRING CASH**, either for fees or for postage. The processing times for Visa applications lodged in person will be the same as stated below. The Embassy of Brazil does not provide expedited or priority services.

PLEASE NOTE: The visa application and the pertinent documentation must be lodged in Brazil, by the applicant or his/her legal representative, with the Brazilian Ministry of Labour. If the application is approved, the Embassy will be authorized to issue the visa, provided that the applicant meets the minimum documentation requirements and pays the appropriate consular fee. Additional documentation may be required in accordance with instructions from the Brazilian Ministry of External Relations.

BEFORE YOU SEND YOUR DOCUMENTATION TO THE EMBASSY OF BRAZIL, please make sure that you are based within the Embassy's jurisdiction area.
