## **Temporary Visas**

Temporary visas may be granted to foreign citizens who wish to travel to Brazil with the intention of establishing residence, for a fixed or for an indefinite period, either for the performance of specific activities under the Brazilian Migration Law, or as a beneficiary of a visa agreement.

## **Temporary Visa XIV (VITEM XIV) – Digital Nomad Visa**

### **Rules and regulation:**

- This type of visa is required for foreign citizens traveling to Brazil for work purposes \_ the so-called digital nomads, who work remotely using information and communication technologies and wish to reside temporarily in Brazil.
- In case of employment relationship, the applicant must provide proof of a job contract.
- For applicants without an employment contract, proof of a sponsoring institution is required.
- Digital Nomad Visas will be good for multiple entries within authorized duration \_ 1 year, and it can be extended for an additional year.

### **Requirements:**

- Fill in the visa application form online at: <https://formulario-mre.serpro.gov.br>
- Print out the receipt page of the form, sign it on the appropriate field (the same way you sign your passport), and glue a recent picture (taken within the last 6 months and with white background) in the indicated space.

All applicants must upload their photo, signature and other documents while filling in the application form.

**The receipt page of the form must be submitted to the Consular Section, along with the following documentation:**

1. Passport, valid for at least six months (the Consular Section of the Embassy reserves the right not to endorse soiled, damaged or defaced passports). The passport must have at least 2 blank pages.
  2. Work/employment contract and introduction letter from the applicant's sponsoring institution.
  3. Cover letter declaring that you are capable of working entirely remotely with the aid of technology.
  4. Documentation proving the nature of your status as a digital nomad.
  5. Health insurance policy valid in Brazil for the duration of your stay.
  6. Police certificate, issued within the last 3 months, certifying absence of criminal record.
  7. Proof of salary exceeding US\$ 1.500,00 per month or bank statement with balance over US\$ 18.000,00.
- **Please note that the requirements listed above should not, in any way, be considered all inclusive. The Consular Section reserves the right to request additional information and/or documentation when deemed necessary.**
