



Visa for digital nomads

Eligibility

- people who are employed outside Brazil or who provide services outside Brazil and wish to reside in and work remotely from Brazil, without local employer sponsorship. Duration: up to one year, renewable for the same period if the applicant continues to meet eligibility criteria;
- Applicants must have a minimum monthly income of USD 1,500 or an available bank balance of at least USD 18,000 at the time of the application. They must be able to prove the income comes from sources outside of Brazil through an employment or services agreement or similar documentation.
- the applicant may also work remotely from Brazil with a tourist visa (VIVIS) or without a visa (if there is a visa waiver for your nationality), provided the applicant does not exceed the period allowed to stay in the country as a tourist;

The application form completed (filled-in) online is valid for three months.

Required Documents

At the Embassy's discretion other documents may be requested if deemed necessary.

- Original Passport (valid for at least six months counting from entry date). The passport must have at least 2 (two) blank visa pages. Please note that the amendment pages are not intended for visas (the Embassy reserves the right not to endorse soiled or defaced passports).
- Application form (RER), completed and signed.
- Round-trip ticket, booked itinerary (reservation) or letter from a travel agent under applicant's name, with complete itinerary, flight number and arrival/departure dates and reservation code provided by the airline company.
- Health insurance valid in Brazil;
- Police clearance (not older than six months)
- Notarized** letter from employer or sponsoring company, clearly stating the applicant's qualification, the precise nature of business, salary and accordance with the applicant's request to work remotely from Brazil;
- Letter signed by the applicant stating that he/she is able work remotely through information technology channels;
- Original contract of employment or services agreement;
- Stamped bank statement of the past three months;

Important:

The Embassy of Brazil in Pretoria **will only accept** visa applications of which the applicant's photograph, signature and other required documents have been duly uploaded to the application form. Instructions on uploading can be found on the application form.

Please note that the documents (including the 3x4 photograph) mentioned in the visa requirements still have to be physically presented at the Embassy.

Applicants may be required to come in person for an interview or to collect their documents, at the discretion of the consular authority.
