CHECKLIST

TOURIST VISA

- 1. Visa application form**, to be completed at <http://formulario-mre.serpro.gov.br>. The receipt of the application – “RER” – must be printed and signed by the applicant or legal guardian;
- 2.** One (1) recent **photograph**, Australian passport size and quality, issued within the last 12 months;
- 3. Original passport**, with at least one (1) blank page and minimum validity left of six (6) months from the date of entry in Brazil;
- 4. Itinerary** showing arrival and departure from Brazil;
- 5. Proof of funds** – bank statement **or** credit card statement issued within the past month showing current balance at time of lodgement (an online print out of the current balance and past month's transaction, showing applicant's name is acceptable). A minimum amount of A\$ 100 per day of stay must be shown;
- 6. Visa Fee** of A\$ 216 (for **Australian** passport holders. **For other nationalities, please email the Visa Department at visa.sydney@itamaraty.gov.br**) payable **exclusively** by a **Standard Australian Money Order** , issued by Australia Post to the “Consulate General of Brazil” – ***please note that online money orders are not accepted. Please use ONE Money Order for each applicant and for each service.***
- **Applicants participating in conferences, seminars, or attending artistic or sporting events must also provide:**
 - An invitation or confirmation letter from the event organisers;
 - Confirmation that the applicant will not be receiving financial remuneration from a Brazilian entity;
- **Applicants under 18 years of age must also provide:**
 - i)** a certified copy (by a *justice of the peace*) of the minor's birth certificate;
 - ii)** a “[Letter of Consent](#)” signed by **BOTH** parents/legal guardians either in person at the Consulate OR before a **NOTARY PUBLIC** (Please be advised that a *Justice of the Peace* is not the same as a Notary Public. The Consulate will only accept signatures witnessed by a Notary Public at the Letter of Consent);
 - iii)** a certified copy (by a *Justice of the Peace*) of both parents'/legal guardians' photo ID (Brazilian ID/Passport for Brazilian parents);
 - iv) for children of Brazilian nationals who are not Brazilian citizens** – A “[Declaração de Recusa em Registrar o Nascimento](#)” must be signed by the Brazilian party before a Justice of the Peace or in person, at the Consulate.

FORMS OF LODGEMENT
